Course Fee \$250 - 2-year instructor certification fee, course materials, range use, firearm use, ammunition and range equipment. (See cancellation/refund policy on application.)

Eligibility To be eligible for this course, instructor candidates must:

- Possess a solid background in firearm safety and pistol shooting skills acquired through previous firearm training or previous shooting experience, and be competently familiar with each type of pistol action.
- Complete and submit a pre-course questionnaire (supplied upon registration through the [nrainstructors.org](http://www.nrainstructors.org) website link: <http://www.nrainstructors.org/SignupStudent.aspx?id=223202>)
- Achieve a minimum score of 90% on the Basic Pistol Shooting Course exam.
- Successfully complete the Pre-Course Qualification Exercises conducted at the Clark County Shooting Complex Range on Friday morning January 10th from 9:00am to Noon.

During the course

- Instructor candidates will be required to demonstrate solid and safe pistol handling skills and successfully complete the classroom and qualification exercises.
- Instructor candidates must receive the endorsement of the NRA Training Counselor conducting the course to become NRA-certified pistol instructors.

Note: Should any candidate not fulfill all of the course requirements, the candidate may be accepted as an NRA Assistant Instructor until all such requirements are completed satisfactorily.

Course Limit: 20 students

Application Deadline: 5 PM EST, Monday December 30, 2013

Applications are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Your online registration will be confirmed via email by NRA staff and will include the Pre-Course Questionnaire, Basic Pistol Exam and Registration forms to be filled out and returned with your payment. It will also include a copy of the Pre-Qualification Form so you can prepare for Friday morning at the range.
